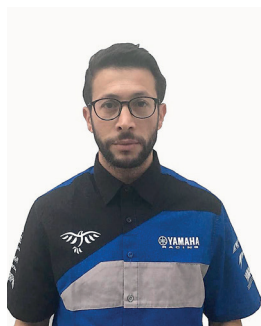

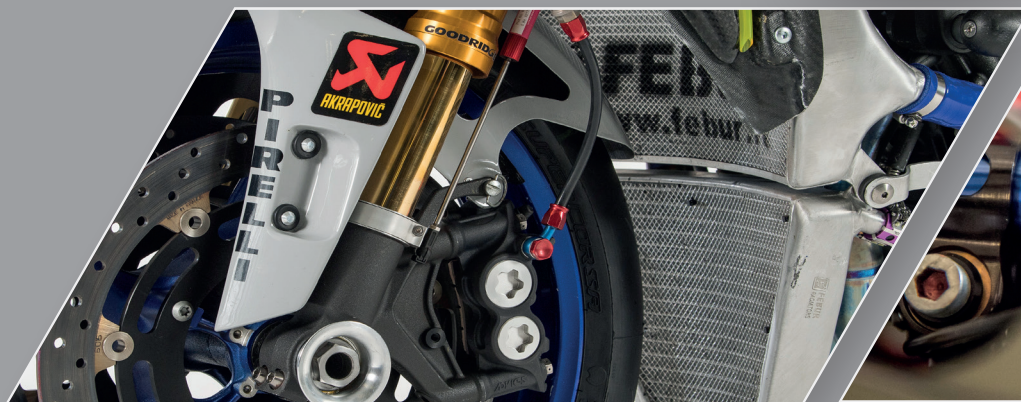

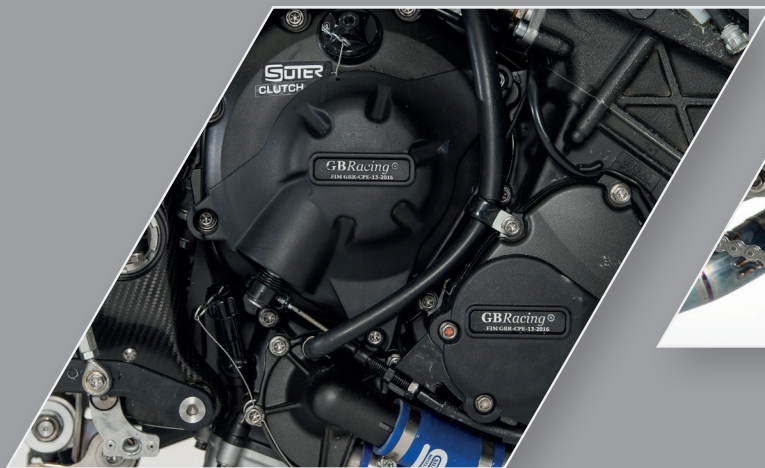

GMT94 members interventions in schools are about road safety issues and always lead to the reception of trainees. Throughout the year, the GMT94 workshop receives and trains young Val-de-Marnais.



ATTITUDE PRÉVENTION.



Attitude Prévention is an association that brings together all French insurers.

Prevention is an integral part of the insurance business. It is a cause in which all commit themselves, inseparable from their social responsibility.

In terms of road risks, Attitude Prévention, thanks to its experience and expertise, offers original awareness-raising actions such as the CRS / Attitude Prévention road safety track.

In partnership with the Ministry of the Interior, the track CRS / Attitude Prévention introduces young riders to good safety practices. Each year, some thirty operations are organized throughout the country, raising the awareness of more than 10,000 people, including 9,000 school children.



Through his prevention actions with Val-de-Marne teenagers, Christophe Guyot and his team, GMT94, are part of the same commitment as Attitude Prévention, in terms of protection and training of future riders of motorised two-wheelers.

Therefore, Christophe Guyot is an ambassador for the CRS / Attitude Prévention road safety track.

GMT94 presence alongside Attitude Prévention contributes to a vision of motorised two-wheeler reconciling freedom and respect for others, pleasure and safety, sportsmanship and risk control.

Because it brings the world closer to motorcycle racing and the two-wheeler users, this partnership helps to promote responsible riding.

GMT94 WORKSHOP.



Both GMT94 Yamaha R6 machines are fully prepared at the GMT94 workshop. The base is a stock motorcycle. Radiator, fairings and all parts that regulations allow to change are handmade. Many technical partners also help to prepare the bike (see technical data sheet on Yamaha R6 page). All GYTR kit parts also equip the GMT94 Yamaha R6.

Benoît POUPARDIN, workshop chief, sets the bike up and participates in the development.

Sébastien CARRÉ, logistic manager, is in close touch with Mac Moto

for composite parts production. Some are carbon autoclave. Others in polyester «aviorace» as imposed by the technical regulations.

Alexandre LEROY, data engineer, takes care of all the electronic and electrical parts of the bike.

Grégory REBEYRAT, chief mechanic, validates the parts before assembly and takes care of preparing all the spare parts.

Olivier De Andres, joins GMT94 Yamaha in 2019 to end his electronic engineer training.

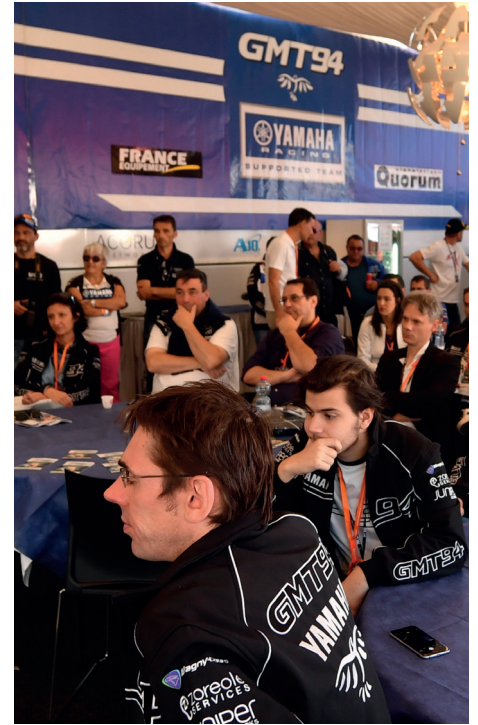


OFFICIAL FAN CLUB OF GMT94

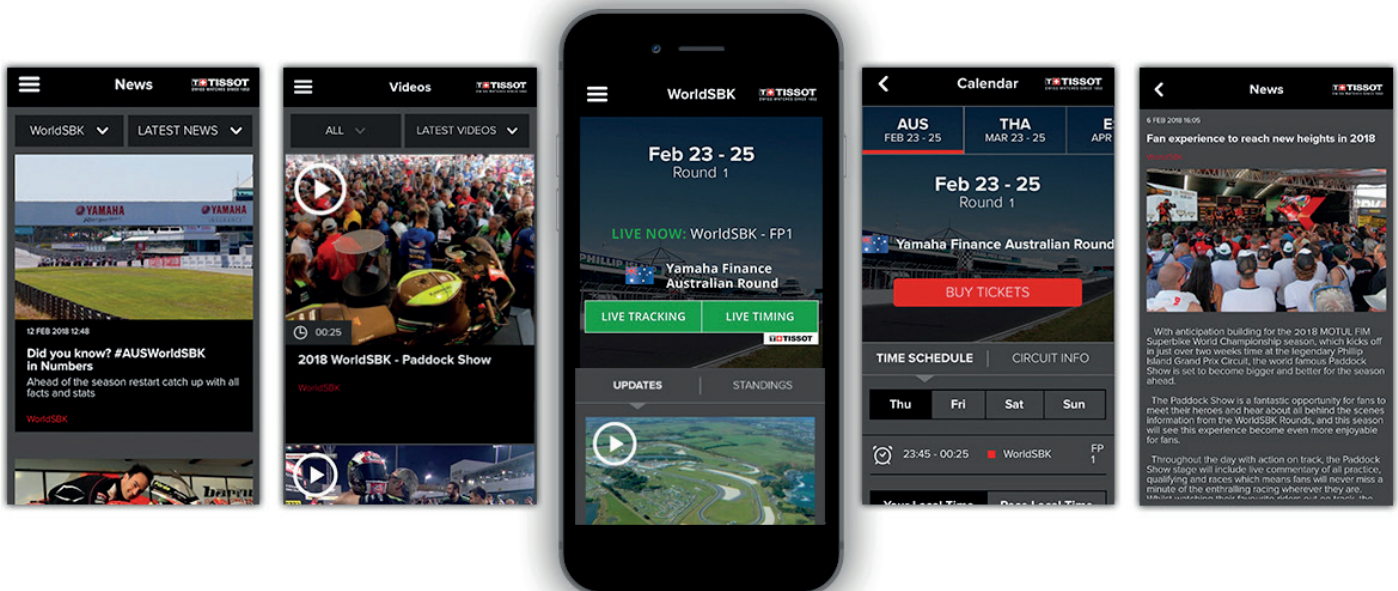

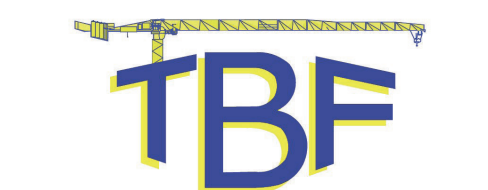
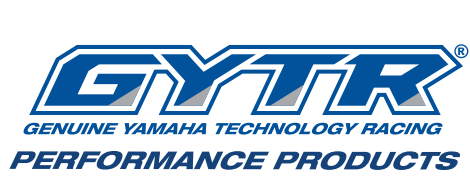
